Here's more detail about the role:

The full-time role is based in either our Wellington or Auckland offices and requires someone who can understand the challenges that our clients face. Most of our clients are in the Construction industry (it's our speciality) and working on Residential Construction sites (think, blocks of apartments as well as single-family homes).

We are after someone who can

- Confidentiality audit a range of construction sites with the aim of helping the team improve their site safety performance.
- Meet with the clients at a regular H&S meeting to coach them on how to improve.
- Speak to groups of between 2 & 50 tradies to deliver great toolbox talk.
- Come up with fresh thinking & new ideas to help us improve the safety standards across all our sites.
